ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE

THIS IS TO CERTIFY THAT THE PROPONENT, MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF MULANAY, QUEZON is granted with this Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) for the Concreting of San Isidro-Canuyep-F. Nanadiego-Matataja-Patabog-Ibabang Yuni Farm to Market Road and Construction of a Bridge Project located at Mulanay, Quezon the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), through the Environmental Management Bureau (EMB), CALABARZON Region.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project involves the Concreting of San Isidro-Canuyep-F. Nanadiego-Matataja-Patabog-Ibabang Yuni Farm to Market Road with a total length of Fifteen Thousand Seven Hundred (15,700) linear meters and Construction of Bridge with a total length of Forty (40) linear meters. It shall cover Sitios Panawsawan, Dingabing, Ilayang Cambalo and Ibabang Cambalo at Barangay San Isidro; Sitios Luya and Bobo at Barangay Canuyep; Sitio Himbabalod at Barangay F. Nananiego; Sitio Himbabalod at Barangay Matataja; Sitios Sanperu, Central, Old Patabog and Mugos at Barangay Patabog; Sitios Mugos, Bungalonan and Bayanan at Barangay Ibabang Yuni, Mulanay, Quezon.

This Certificate is issued in compliance to the requirements of Presidential Decree No. 1586, in accordance to Department Administrative Order No. 2003-30. The Bureau, however, is not precluded from reevaluating, adding, removing, and correcting any deficiencies or errors that may be found after issuance of this Certificate.

I. CONDITIONS

ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT AND MONITORING PLAN

The proponent shall strictly implement the following mitigating, enhancement and rehabilitating measures:

- 1. That preservation and easement retention of natural drainage/waterways shall be undertaken and should conform with the provisions of the DENR Administrative Order No. 97-05 (Procedures in the Retention of Areas within certain distances along the Banks of Rivers, Streams, and Shores of Seas, Lakes and Oceans for Environmental Protection). Native tree species shall be planted and maintained along the easement from the start of project implementation to enhance soil stability and provide aesthetics.
- 2. That effective and adequate drainage system shall be constructed by the proponent.
- 3. That health and sanitation practices shall be observed at all times. Safety and personal protective equipment/devices shall also be provided to the employees/workers to prevent health and occupational hazards.
- 4. That in support of the concern of the government to phase-out mercury from all possible sources and to address global warming, the proponent shall install environment-friendly lighting fixtures (i.e. light-emitting diode lamps, compact fluorescent lamps, etc.).
- 5. That from the commencement of the project, the proponent and/or contractor shall implement the following:
 - a) Effective Information, Education and Communication (IEC) Plan shall be implemented in all project phases including communication of environmental risks of the project implementation.
 - b) Beneficial Social Development Program (SDP) among the employees/workers, host barangay and affected communities which shall cover livelihood training and employment, including assistance in the setting-up of social welfare programs for health and education that will ensure the participation of youth and women.
 - c) Appropriate wastes management scheme as provided in the Environmental Management Plan (EMP) shall be continuously implemented.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Further administrative conditions for the grant of this Certificate shall be strictly complied:

6. That the proponent shall religiously comply with the applicable provisions of P.D. 1586 (Philippine Environmental Impact Statement System), R.A. 9003 (Ecological and Solid Waste Management Act of 2000), R.A. 6969 (Toxic Substances and Hazardous and Nuclear Waste Control Act of 1990), R.A. 8749 (Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999) and R.A. 9275 (Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004).

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- 7. That the proponent shall allocate appropriate budget for the implementation of the proposed mitigating/enhancement measures during the operation and abandonment phases of the project.
- 8. That the proponent shall handle all environment related aspects of the project in addition to the monitoring requirements as specified in the Environmental Management Plan (EMP)/Environmental Monitoring Plan (EMOP) such as but not limited to the following:
 - 8.1 Monitor actual project impacts vis-à-vis the predicted impacts and management measures in the IEE Checklist Report;
 - 8.2 Submit all environmental monitoring reports to this Office quarterly using the prescribed format of the Self-Monitoring Report (SMR) pursuant to DAO 2003-27;
 - 8.3 Ensure that post-assessment permits/clearances are in place;
 - 8.4 Submit a semi-annual self-monitoring reports (every January 15 and July 15 of each year the project is operational) which serve as summary of all the SMRs submitted quarterly pursuant to DAO 2003-30 (Implementing Rules and Regulations of PD 1586); and
 - 8.5 Submit an Abandonment Plan two (2) months prior to abandonment. It shall include rehabilitation measures, clean-up and presentation of proposed alternative projects in the area.
- 9. That a billboard containing this message: "Notice to the Public, This CONCRETING OF SAN ISIDRO-CANUYEP-F. NANADIEGO-MATATAJA-PATABOG-IBABANG YUNI FARM TO MARKET ROAD AND CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE PROJECT has been issued an ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE (ECC-R4A-11410-0578) by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources-Environmental Management Bureau CALABARZON Region on ______." must be installed at the entry/exit point of the project to inform the general public within thirty (30) days upon receipt of ECC
- 10. That the proponent, Municipal Government of Mulanay, Quezon, represented by its Municipal Mayor, Hon. Joselito A. Ojeda shall be severally accountable for any misrepresentation and failure to state material information in the submitted document.
- 11. That any authorized DENR-EMB personnel with proper identification card and travel/mission order shall have unconditional access to conduct an on-the-spot inspection and monitoring without the need for prior notice to oversee compliance to the ECC.

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
II. RESTRICTIONS

The proponent is strictly subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. That no other activities should be undertaken other than what was stipulated in the IEECR. Should there be an expansion and/or deviation of the project beyond the project description, construction of other structures beyond those stated in the IEECR; or any change in the activity, shall be made subject to a new Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) requirements.
- 2. That no trees shall be affected in all phases of the project, or if there is any, necessary documents such as "Tree Cutting Permit", "Balling Permit" and other permits/clearances, shall be secured from the concerned DENR sector.
- 3. That the transfer of ownership/operation of this project carries with it the responsibility of complying with all the conditions in this ECC, the transfer of which shall be made known to this Office through a written notification by herein grantee within fifteen (15) days from such transfer.

The conditions stipulated in this Certificate shall be deemed final within fifteen (15) days from receipt hereof and all conditions set forth above shall be complied with by the herein grantee. This ECC is deemed expired if not implemented within five (5) years from the date of issuance and the proponent shall have to apply for a new ECC if it intends to pursue the project.

Non-compliance with any of the provisions of this Certificate shall be a sufficient cause for the cancellation or suspension of this Certificate and/or imposition of a fine in an amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php 50,000.00) for every violation thereof.
